The first Parent- Teacher Meeting for the students from first year to final year B.Sc nursing was conducted on July 30, 2022 by Mrs. Vatchala Devi, Principal. To ensure effective communication, parents were notified through phone calls, and WhatsApp messages well in advance. This event commenced at 9am. specific time lines were allotted for parents to meet the mentors or their ward and the respective department teachers ensured a smooth conduct of the event.

The aim of the meeting was to inform parents of their ward's academic performance, attendance status, and overall discipline. The parent was handed over a detailed form with their attendance percentage, internal assessment marks, and comments, signed by the respective department heads.

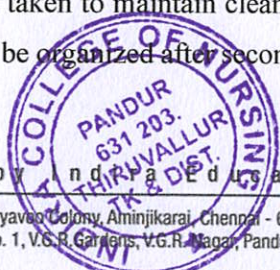
Subsequently, parents were guided to interact with the concerned subject teachers to gain insights into their academic progress. The teachers discussed about student's performance in individual subjects, emphasizing areas, which require additional attention. This proactive approach is meant to help parents and students to deal with challenges, creating a supportive environment that can lead to better academic performance in future exams.


The department staff members emphasized the significance of meeting attendance requirements, university eligibility criteria, and the criteria for appearing for the TN Dr MGR Medical examinations. They provided valuable insights into clinical subjects and their importance, particularly for parents of first-year and second-year students, encouraging the development of strong clinical skills.

Additionally, the department staff requested the parents to monitor their ward's weekly academic performance, ensuring regular attendance, especially in subjects where improvement is needed for better results. As the meeting wrapped up, parents were guided to meet the mentors responsible for overseeing their ward's overall performance. Parents, who were unable to attend the meeting were sought an email to the ICON official address, citing the reason for non-attendance. Students with low attendance percentages were requested to meet with the principal, with their parents.

Some parents complained common rooms were not cleaned regularly. The parents were assured that necessary steps would be taken to maintain cleanliness in the common room. The Parents were informed that the next meeting will be organized after second internal assessment to discuss their wards performance and progress.

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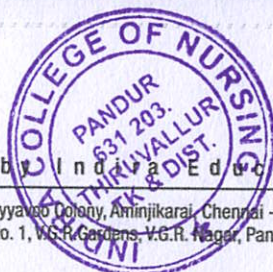

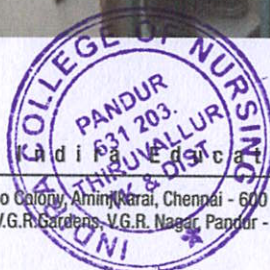
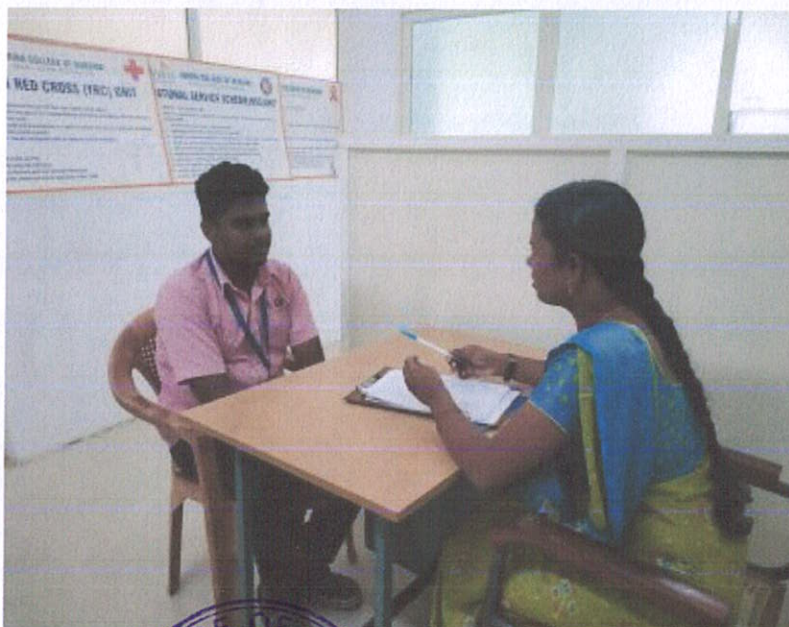

- T₁, T₂, T₃, T₄ - size.

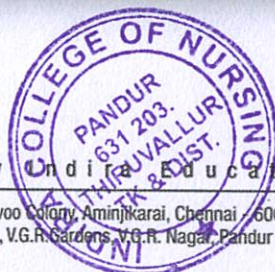
